Regular Guy Beanie

Gauge

20 st over 4 inches

Size

Pattern written for a 24" head. Measure wearer and adjust CO in 4st increments.

Materials

50g or about 100 yards Aran/Worsted weight wool

Needles

US size 6 or 7 DPNs or size to achive gauge



CO 84 sts. place a marker and join in the round making sure not to twist. Evenly distribute the sts on 4 DPNs.

Next round *K2, P2* around.

Continue K2P2 rib until hat measures 2"

On next round switch to stockinette St (knit all)

Continue stockinette until hat measures 5.5"

Begin decrease on next round. If CO number was adjusted divide your number of sts by 6 and K2tog the last two sts.

Decrease

Round 1: *K12, K2tog, repeat from *

Round 2: Knit all

Round 3: *K11, K2tog, repeat from *

Round 4: Knit all

Continue in the manner until you have 24 sts left on the needles and have completed a Knit all round.

The next three rounds decrease every row. This will prevent the top of hat from having a point.

When there are 6 sts left on the needles break the yarn and thread through the 6 sts.

Finish by sewing in ends.
