SEAFARER'S SCARF

The original seafarer scarf worn the world over!
Pattern and instructions courtesy of *Seamen's Church Institute (SCI)*.

MATERIALS: Approx. 300 yds. worsted weight yarn

US size 6 or 7 needle (or size needed for gauge)

GAUGE: 5 st = 1"



Finished measurements:
approximately 6.5" x 46"

Cast on 32 stitches.

Knit even for 14"

K4, P4 for 18"

Knit even for 14"

Bind off with medium
tension, and weave in all
ends.

Tip: slip the first stitch of each row purl wise to neaten the edges.

Note: The 18 inches of ribbing will make the neck of the scarf narrow looking. This makes the scarf denser and warmer around the neck without adding extra bulk.
